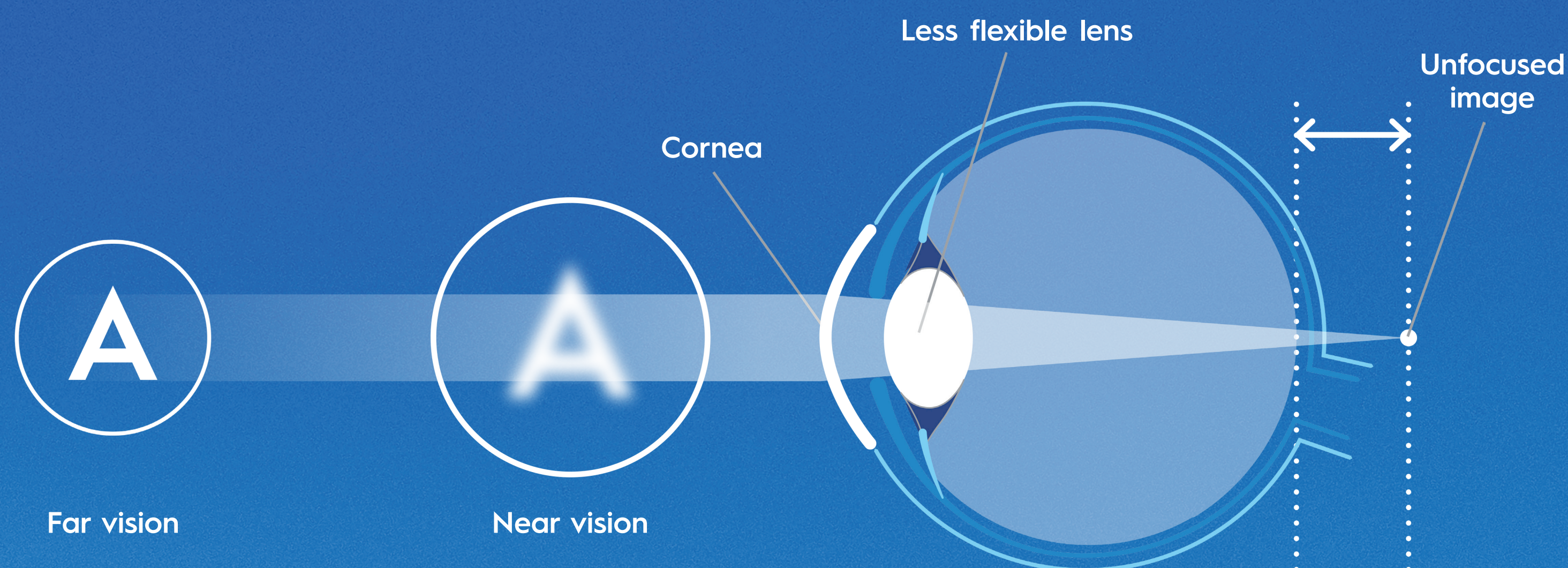


Extending arms to see things better

Presbyopia is an eye condition that leads to gradually losing the ability to see things clearly up close, such as the text on your mobile phone or a restaurant menu.

This process typically starts to occur between the age of 40-45 years for everyone.



Within our eyes, the crystalline lens allows us to focus from distance to near objects by changing its shape. Over time, the crystalline lens loses its elasticity and becomes less flexible. As a result, the lens no longer changes shape easily, and it becomes harder to see things close-up.
